## **FINAL CONFERENCE OF LION PROJECT**

The final conference of "Local Alliance for Integration" (LION) project, funded by the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund of the European Union (AMIF-2016-AG-INTE), will be held on Friday, November 29, 2019 09:00 - 18:00 at the Conference Room of School of Public Health (former NSPH), 196 Alexandra Ave., Athens.

After 2 years of implementing activities, the conference aims to present its results regarding the integration of Third Country Nationals (TCNs) into the local community in the field of health care, labour market, social care, formal education and intercultural coexistence. In addition, the main goal of the conference is to create a forum of dialogue, where, through the presentations and the discussion, TCNs needs and challenges, as mapped by the project's actions will be highlighted, aiming to network stakeholders at multiple levels of governance.

The conference will bring together, besides the project partners, representatives of TCNs organizations, local authorities, and policy makers, as well as academics and researchers involved in TCNs integration in the fields of health, employment, social care, formal education and intercultural coexistence.
